Information about Regulation: REACH

The enterprise Beraca, in accordance to the Regulation of the European Union concerning Registry, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemical Products (EC1907/2006), informs the following :

- *As of June 2008, substances placed on the market in quantities above 1000 (y/t) must be registered in three and a half years; 100 to 1000 (y/t) in six years and from 1 to 100 (y/t) in eleven years. Substances identified as “causing risk”, considered of great concern, are to be evaluated with priority during the first three years. Such substances fall in the following categories: **CMR** (carcinogenic, mutagenic, or causing harm to the reproductive system), **PBT** (persistent, bio-accumulative and toxic) and **vPvBs** (very persistent and very bio-accumulative). The use of these substances will be submitted to authorization by the Agency (special registry process)....*

All substances belonging to Beraca exported and sold to the European Union, conform to the 1 to 100 yearly category. Therefore, all our products will be registered in the period of 11 years, counted as of June 2008 onwards.

We emphasize that all requirements and up-dating will be fulfilled according to the dates established in Regulation (EC) 1907/2006 of the European Union concerning Registry, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemical Products (REACH).
